A Night Of Guamania Filipiniana

Tropical sound waves from the islands of Guam, Philippines and Pacificana-Polynesia should make a big splash this August 11, 1989 at the San Diego Marriott Hotel and Marina starting at 7 p.m., when Guam's international entertainer and recording superstar Jimmy Dee combines song power and energy with Philippines' superstar -- total entertainer Rico J. Puno and the island enchantments and excitements of Guam's famous glamour girls -- The Chamorritas.
